Winfred E. Eye's fifth full-length release, *Today Was Another Day*, packs 12 songs destined to be favorites to both old and new ears. Recorded over two years in Oakland and San Francisco, the songs were engineered by Mikel Garmendia, Jeremy Goody, and Drew Zajicek. The band invites you to take some time to listen to their new batch and lose yourself in their world – it's a world where roads are paved and potholed, where dreams do and don't come true, where beauty meets pain, appetites are insatiable, and love is both lost and found. As always, the jokes are piled high, and the riddles are easy.
